movement started in *Industry and Idleness*, away from depicting the laughable foibles of fashionable society (as he had done with *Marriage A-la-Mode*) and towards a more cutting satire on the problems of poverty and crime. Visceral fat is composed of several adipose depots including mesenteric, epididymal white adipose tissue (EWAT), and perirenal fat. An excess of adipose visceral fat is known as central obesity, the "pot belly" or "beer belly" effect, in which the abdomen protrudes excessively.
