Parvovirus B19 Individuals with B19 IgG antibodies are generally considered immune to recurrent infection, but reinfection Parvovirus B19 (also called B19 virus (B19V), Human parvovirus B19, or sometimes erythrovirus B19) is a human virus most known for causing disease in children, though it can also affect adults. The virus's name is derived from Latin parvum, meaning 'small', as B19 ranks among the smallest DNA viruses, measuring only 23–26 nm in diameter. The virus was discovered by chance in 1975 by Australian virologist Yvonne Cossart. It is the classic cause of the childhood rash called fifth disease or erythema infectiosum. before becoming symptomatic, but probably not after. HCMV infection is typically unnoticed in healthy people, but can be life-threatening for the immunocompromised, such as HIV-infected persons, organ transplant recipients, or newborn infants. Congenital cytomegalovirus infection can lead to significant morbidity and even death. After infection, HCMV remains latent within the body throughout life and can be reactivated at any time. When not inside an infected cell or in the process of infecting a cell, viruses exist in the form of independent viral particles, or virions, consisting of (i) genetic material, i.e., long molecules of DNA or RNA that encode the structure of the proteins by which the virus acts; (ii) a protein coat, the capsid, which surrounds and protects the genetic material; and in some cases (iii) an outside envelope of lipids. 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Infectious mononucleosis Immunoglobulin G (IgG), when positive, mainly reflects a past infection, whereas immunoglobulin M (IgM) Infectious mononucleosis (IM, mono), also known as glandular fever, is an infection usually caused by the Epstein-Barr virus (EBV). In young adults, the disease often results in fever, sore throat, enlarged lymph nodes in the neck, and fatigue. antibodies directed against the Epstein-Barr virus. Most people recover in two to four weeks; however, fatigue may last months. The liver or spleen may also become swollen, and in less than one percent of cases splenic rupture may occur. The most common disease derived from parvovirus B19 is fifth disease. This disease is spread in close contact through respiratory droplets, which can be from the nose, mouth, or direct contact with an infected person. Fifth disease is most commonly spread in the winter and spring seasons among children aged six to fourteen years old. Parvovirus B19 begins replicating anywhere from four to eighteen days after infection. Infected children are most contagious during this period, before they develop the most notable sign—a red rash on their cheeks—along with other symptoms. e54b50b09b

EpiVacCorona The conclusions and results of the trial have not been made public. The lack of protective effectiveness of EpiVacCorona, which is still in use in Russia, has been reported in scientific literature and in the media. The vaccine consists of three chemically synthesized peptides (short fragments of a viral spike protein) that are conjugated to a large carrier protein. A phase III clinical trial to show whether or not the vaccine can protect people against COVID-19 was launched in November 2020 with more than three thousand participants. The cause is usually herpes simplex virus type 1 (HSV-1) and occasionally herpes simplex virus type 2 (HSV-2). The infection is typically spread between people by direct non-sexual contact. Attacks can be triggered by sunlight, fever, psychological

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stress, or a menstrual period. Direct contact with the genitals can result in genital herpes. Diagnosis is usually based on symptoms but can be confirmed with specific testing. While usually caused by the Epstein-Barr virus, also known as human herpesvirus 4, which is a member of the herpesvirus family, a few other viruses and the protozoon *Toxoplasma gondii* may also cause the disease. It is primarily spread through saliva but can rarely be spread through semen or blood. Spread may occur by objects such as drinking glasses or toothbrushes, or through a cough or sneeze. Those who are infected can spread the disease weeks before symptoms develop. Mono is primarily diagnosed based on the symptoms and can be confirmed with blood tests for specific antibodies. Another typical finding is increased blood lymphocytes of which more than 10% are reactive... Since parvovirus B19 is a single stranded DNA virus, replication... Erythroviruses belong to the Parvoviridae family of small DNA viruses. It is in the genus Erythroparvovirus and assigned to the species Erythroparvovirus primate1. Human parvovirus B19 is a non-enveloped, icosahedral virus that contains a single-stranded linear DNA genome of approximately 5,600 base pairs in length. B19V's nonenveloped viral particles are ~22 to 24 nm in diameter which are quite small compared to other parvoviruses. The infectious particles may contain either positive or negative strands of DNA. The icosahedral capsid consists of 60 capsomeres, consisting of two structural...

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
