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the shots to each other) is a measure of the precision of the launching weapon, and a measure of the shooter's consistency and skill. ballistic impacts) on a shooting target from multiple consecutive shots taken in one shooting session. On the other hand, the grouping's displacement (the distance between the calculated group center and the intended point of aim) is a measure of accuracy

== History ==
The genus *Puntigrus* was erected in 2013 to hold several species previously identified as *P. tetrazona*, and members of the genus are sometimes referred to broadly as tiger barbs.

Board foot can be abbreviated as FBM (for "foot, board measure"), BDFT, or BF. A thousand board feet can be abbreviated as MFBM, MBFT, or MBF. Similarly, a million board feet can be abbreviated as MMFBM, MMBFT, or MMBF.

Members of this genus, including *Puntigrus anchisporus*, *Puntigrus navjotsodhii*, and *Puntigrus partipentazona*, are similar in appearance to *Puntius tetrazona*, with only slight differences in stripe pattern and number of scales.

Until the 1970s, in Australia and New Zealand, the terms super foot and superficial foot were used with the same meaning.

== Uses of the term ==

Pixel density Horizontal and vertical density are usually the same, as most devices have square pixels, but differ on devices that have non-square pixels. Considered in another way, a pixel has no inherent size or unit (a pixel is actually a sample), but when it is printed, displayed, or scanned, then the pixel has both a physical size (dimension) and a pixel density (ppi). the pixels per inch of the output:

 Pixels per inch (ppi) and pixels per centimetre (ppcm or pixels/cm) are measurements of the pixel density of an electronic image device, such as a computer monitor or a television set's display, or image digitizing device such as a camera or image

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scanner. Pixel density is not the same as resolution—where the former describes the amount of detail on a physical surface or device, the latter describes the amount of pixel information regardless of its scale

Tightness of shot groupings are calculated by measuring the maximum distance between any two bullet holes on the target (center-to-center) in length measurements such as millimeters or inches. Often that measurement is converted into angular measurements such as milliradians ("mils" or "mrads") or minutes of angle (MOAs), which expresses the size of shot scatter regardless of the target distance. Thus, by using angular measurements, one can reliably compare the relative tightness of shot groupings fired at different distances.
