For example, the composite number 299 can be written as 13×23 , and the composite number 360 can be written as $2^3 \times 3^2 \times 5$; furthermore, this representation is unique up to the order of the factors. This fact is called the fundamental theorem of arithmetic. dedd05e2d7

Prime number A prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. The property of being prime is called primality. A simple but slow method of checking the primality of a given number dedd05e2d7 There are two types of factors: primary and secondary. The previously mentioned primary factors are land, labour and capital. Materials and energy are considered secondary factors in classical economics because they are obtained from land, labour, and capital. The primary factors facilitate production but neither become part of the product (as with raw materials) nor become significantly transformed by the production process (as with fuel used to power machinery). Land includes not only the site of production but also natural resources above or below the soil. Recent usage has distinguished human capital (the... dedd05e2d7

Composite number is by counting the number of prime factors. Every positive integer is composite, prime, or the unit 1, so the composite numbers are exactly the natural numbers that are not prime and not a unit. For example, the integer 14 is a composite number because it is the product of the two smaller integers 2 and 7; however, the integers 2 and 3 are not because each can only be divided by one and itself. A composite number with two prime factors is a semiprime or 2-almost prime (the factors need not be distinct A composite number is a positive

integer that can be formed by multiplying two smaller positive integers. Accordingly, it is a positive integer that has at least one divisor other than 1 and itself dedd05e2d7

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
