Tonsil stones contain a biofilm composed of several different bacteria, and calcium salts, either alone or in combination with other mineral salts. While they most commonly occur in the palatine tonsils, they may also occur in the adenoids, lingual tonsils and tubal tonsil. Tonsil stones have been recorded weighing from 0.3 g to 42 g, and they are typically small in size. However, there are occasional reports of large tonsilloliths. They are often discovered during medical imaging for other reasons, and more recently, due to the impact and influence of social media platforms such as TikTok, medical...

When used unqualified, the term most commonly refers specifically to the palatine tonsils, which are two lymphoid organs situated at either side of the back of the human throat. The palatine tonsils and the adenoid tonsil are organs consisting of lymphoepithelial tissue located near the oropharynx and nasopharynx (parts of the throat). Humans are born with four types of tonsils: the pharyngeal tonsil, two tubal tonsils, two palatine tonsils and the lingual tonsils.

Tonsil stones Tonsil stones have been recorded weighing Tonsil stones, also known as tonsilloliths, are mineralizations of debris within the crevices of the tonsils. Symptoms may include bad breath, foreign body sensation, sore throat, pain or discomfort with swallowing, and cough. The presence of tonsil stones may be otherwise undetectable; however, some people have reported seeing white material in the rear of their throat. commonly occur in the palatine tonsils, they may also occur in the adenoids, lingual tonsils and tubal tonsil. Generally there is no pain, though there may be the feeling of something present. When not mineralized, the presence of debris is known as chronic caseous tonsillitis (CCT)

Tonsil These organs play an important role in the immune system. The tonsils (TON-sills) are a set of lymphoid organs facing into the aerodigestive tract, which is known as Waldeyer's tonsillar ring and consists of the adenoid tonsil (or pharyngeal tonsil), two tubal tonsils, two palatine tonsils, and the lingual tonsils. These organs play an important role in the immune system.

Palatine tonsil Palatine tonsils, commonly called the tonsils and occasionally called the faucial tonsils, are tonsils located on the left and right sides at the back of the mouth.

Adenoiditis Rhinorrhea with serous secretion in viral forms and mucous-purulent secretion in bacterial forms. In cases due to viral infection symptoms usually recede.
