Nicocodeine Nicocodeine and nicomorphine were synthesized in 1904, and introduced in 1957 by Lannacher Heilmittel of Austria. The definitive synthesis, which involves treating anhydrous codeine base with nicotinic anhydride at 130 °C, was published by Pongratz and Zirm in Monatshefte für Chemie in 1957, simultaneously with the two analogues in an article about amides and esters of

various organic acids. Related opioid analogues such as nicomorphine and nicocodeine were first synthesized. Nicocodeine is metabolised in the liver by demethylation to produce nicomorphine, also known as 6-nicotinoylmorphine, and subsequently further metabolised to morphine. It is not commonly used in most countries, but has activity similar to other opiates. In Europe, it is not recommended as a cough medicine for those under 12 years of age. It usually starts working after half an hour, with maximum effect at two hours.
