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Trichodectes ovis and later *Damalinia Bovicola ovis*, the sheep body louse, is a chewing louse that afflicts sheep across the world. They generally have a reddish-brown head and a pale cream-colored or yellow-colored body. It does not pierce the skin to drink blood; rather, it feeds on hair and oil secretions, loose skin flakes, and epidermal debris at the base of the wool. It spreads from sheep to sheep via direct contact of fleeces, and lives on their skin and wool. Adults gain brown stripes swathed across their body. Lice are small, measuring just 1.5 to 2 millimeters (0.08 inches) across as adults.

There are two types of cleaner fish, obligate full time cleaners and facultative part time cleaners where different strategies occur based on resources and local abundance of fish. Cleaning behaviour takes place in pelagic waters... Infested sheep are irritated by the lice and will attempt to scratch their itching fleece, damaging it. Cleaner fish A wide variety of fish including wrasse, cichlids, catfish, pipefish, lumpsuckers, and gobies display cleaning behaviors across the globe in fresh, brackish, and marine waters but specifically concentrated in the tropics due to high parasite density. Similar behaviour is found in other groups of animals, such as cleaner shrimps. The client animals are typically fish of a different species, but can also be aquatic reptiles (sea turtles and marine iguana), mammals (manatees and whales), or octopuses. This example of cleaning symbiosis represents mutualism and cooperation behaviour, an ecological interaction that benefits both parties involved. However, the cleaner fish may consume mucus or tissue, thus creating a form of parasitism called cheating.

not normally interbreed. From genetic studies, they are thought to have diverged as subspecies approximately 30,000–110,000 years ago, when many humans began to wear significant amounts of clothing. Proponents argue that such a proxy is necessary because lice screening is prone to false negative conclusions (i.
