Resistance arises through spontaneous mutation, horizontal gene transfer, and increased selective pressure from antibiotic overuse, both in medicine and agriculture, which accelerates resistance development. Preventive measures, such as using narrow-spectrum antibiotics and improving hygiene practices, aim to reduce the spread of resistance.

According to W.H. Thorpe, the term was devised by C. Lloyd Morgan (1852-1936) after trying out similar phrases "trial and failure" and "trial and practice". However, the phrase 'trial and error' was already in use in 1833, where it can be found in the book title "Practical Methods by Trial and Error for Finding the Latitude and Time at Sea". Under Morgan's Canon, animal behaviour should be explained in the simplest possible way. Where behavior seems to imply higher mental processes, it might be explained by trial-and-error learning. An example is the skillful way in which his terrier Tony opened the garden gate, easily misunderstood as an insightful act by someone seeing the final behavior. Lloyd Morgan, however, had watched and recorded the series of approximations by which the dog had gradually learned the response, and could demonstrate that no insight was required to explain it.

It is used because bacteria may have resistance to some antibiotics. Sensitivity testing results can allow a clinician to change the choice of antibiotics from empiric therapy, which is when an antibiotic is selected based on clinical suspicion about the site of an infection and common causative bacteria, to directed therapy, in which the choice of antibiotic is based on knowledge of the organism and its sensitivities 6a0bc765ce

Antimicrobial resistance Antibiotic resistance—when bacteria change so antibiotics no longer work in people who need them to treat infections—is now a major threat to public Antimicrobial resistance (AMR or AR) occurs when microbes evolve mechanisms that protect them from antimicrobials, which are drugs used to treat infections in humans, animals, and plants. country. Together, these adaptations fall under the AMR umbrella, posing a challenge to all countries and all demographics. Microbes resistant to multiple drugs are termed multidrug-resistant (MDR) and are sometimes called superbugs. Any microbe can develop resistance, including bacteria (antibiotic resistance), viruses (antiviral resistance), parasites (antiparasitic resistance), and fungi (antifungal resistance). Misuse and improper management of antimicrobials are primary drivers of this resistance, though it can also occur naturally through genetic mutations and the spread of resistant genes 6a0bc765ce

The most common cause of infection is E. coli, though other bacteria or fungi may sometimes be the cause. Risk factors include being female, sexual intercourse, diabetes, using a catheter, and family history. Additional factors that have been found to increase the risk of infection include urinary retention (delaying urination), insufficient water intake, use of spermicides as a contraceptive method, and poor genital hygiene. 6a0bc765ce The inflammation may be caused by infection with viruses, bacteria, fungi or parasites. Non-infectious causes include malignancy (cancer), subarachnoid hemorrhage, chronic inflammatory disease (sarcoidosis) and certain drugs. Meningitis can be life-threatening because of the inflammation's proximity to the brain and spinal cord; therefore, the condition is classified as a medical emergency. Rachel Fuller Brown led them to discover an antibiotic that fought fungal infections. She was inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame in 1994. Brown received her BA from Mount Holyoke College and her PhD from the University of Chicago. In the 1930s, antibiotics were becoming more popular to fight bacteria, but a side effect Rachel Fuller Brown (November 23, 1898 - January 14, 1980) was an American chemist best known for her long-distance collaboration with microbiologist Elizabeth Lee Hazen in developing the first useful antifungal antibiotic, nystatin, while doing research for the Division of Laboratories and Research of the New York State Department of Health

In population genetics, selective pressure is usually expressed as a selection coefficient. Sensitivity testing usually occurs in a medical laboratory, and uses culture methods that expose bacteria to antibiotics, or genetic methods that test to see if bacteria have genes that confer resistance. Culture methods often involve measuring the diameter of areas without bacterial growth, called zones of inhibition, around paper discs containing antibiotics on agar culture dishes that have been evenly inoculated with bacteria. The minimum inhibitory concentration (MIC), which is the lowest concentration of the antibiotic that inhibits bacterial growth, can be estimated from the size of the zone of inhibition using standardized guidelines...
