Sweating sickness epidemics were unique compared with other disease outbreaks of the time. Its cause remains unknown, although it has been suggested that an unknown species of hantavirus was responsible. The onset of symptoms was sudden, and death or recovery often occurred within 8-10 hours. Whereas other epidemics were typically urban and long-lasting, cases of sweating sickness spiked and receded very quickly, significantly affecting rural populations. Other major outbreaks of the English sweating

sickness occurred in 1508, 1517, and 1528, with the last outbreak in 1551, after which the disease apparently vanished 8aee94efd6
