Brackish water It may result from mixing seawater (salt water) and fresh water together, as in estuaries, or it may occur in brackish fossil aquifers. The Caspian Sea is the world's largest lake and contains brackish water with a salinity about one-third that of normal seawater. Brackish water, sometimes termed brack water, is water occurring in a natural environment that has more salinity than freshwater, but not as much as seawater. Because brackish water is hostile to the growth of most terrestrial plant species, without appropriate management it can be damaging to the environment (see article on shrimp farms). Brackish water is also the primary waste product of the salinity gradient power process. less saline surface waters. The word comes from the Middle Dutch root brak. It had a racetrack preceding Oaklawn as early as 1838. 2f3cde190b == History == 2f3cde190b Sediment samples from below the deep seafloor of the Mediterranean Sea, which include evaporite minerals, soils, and fossil plants, show that the precursor of the Strait of Gibraltar closed about 5.96 million years ago, sealing the Mediterranean off from the Atlantic. This resulted in a period of partial desiccation of the Mediterranean Sea, the first of several such periods during the late Miocene. After the strait closed for the last time around 5.6 Ma, the region's generally dry climate at the time dried the Mediterranean basin out nearly completely within a thousand years. This massive desiccation left a deep dry basin, reaching 3 to 5 km (1.9 to 3.1 mi) deep below normal sea level, with a few hypersaline pockets similar to today's Dead Sea. Ringer's lactate solution It is used for replacing fluids and electrolytes in those who have low blood volume or low blood pressure. It is given by intravenous infusion or applied to the affected area. It may also be used to treat metabolic acidosis and to wash the eye following a chemical burn. Use is generally safe in pregnancy and

Technically, brackish water contains between 0.5 and 30 grams of salt per litre—more often expressed as 0.5 to 30 parts per thousand (‰), which is a specific gravity of between 1.0004 and 1.0226. Thus, brackish covers a range of salinity regimes and is not considered a precisely defined condition. It is characteristic of many brackish surface waters that their salinity can vary...

Seawater Although the vast majority of seawater has a salinity of between 31 and 38 g/kg, that is 3.14 units. 1–3.8%, seawater is not uniformly saline throughout.

Side effects may include allergic reactions, high blood potassium, hypervolemia, and high blood calcium. It may not be suitable for mixing with certain medications and some recommend against use in the same infusion as a blood transfusion.
