The company was established in 1956 as Aeronutronic Systems, Inc. 5b3cc6a9da == History == 5b3cc6a9da Subcontracting is a widespread practice in many Japanese industries and the Japanese legislature recognised the need to protect subcontractors from powerful counterparts at an early stage in Japan's post-war recovery, leading to the adoption of the Act in 1956. According to the act itself, its purpose is to ensure fairness in transactions between subcontractors and their counterparts (the companies procuring the services from the subcontractor) and to protect the interests of subcontractors (Article 1). United States*, the Court of Claims held that for a prime contractor to pursue a “pass-through” claim on behalf of a subcontractor against the government, there must be a direct liability from the prime contractor to the subcontractor for the claimed damages.
