Panraogallus The specimen was made the basis of the new genus and species Panraogallus Panraogallus is an extinct genus of phasianid bird (the family that contains pheasants and their relatives) from the Late Miocene of what is now China. The generic name is the pinyin of the Chinese characters for "coiling" and Latin for "chicken", which refers to the elongated trachea; "coiled chicken" in full. The specimen was made the basis of the new genus and species Panraogallus hezhengensis by the Chinese palaeontologist Zhihen Li and colleagues in 2018. The specific name refers to the Hezheng area, where abundant specimens of this bird have been found. The holotype specimen was discovered in the Liushu Formation near the Zhuangkeji Township in Guanghe County, Gansu Province. elongated, coiled trachea (or windpipe), the oldest known bird fossil with such a structure. The specimen consists of an almost complete skeleton of a young adult (perhaps a male, since it appears to have had a spur), though part of the skull and the neck vertebrae were reconstructed in plaster before the specimen was acquired by the Hezheng Paleozoological Museum. Tracheobronchomalacia reported that a cure had been developed via a 3D printed windpipe. It is mainly linked to genetic causes. This cure has currently saved the lives of at least 3 infants. Tracheobronchomalacia (TBM) is a condition characterized by flaccidity of the tracheal support cartilage which leads to tracheal collapse. There are two forms of this condition: primary TBM and secondary TBM. Secondary TBM is acquired and starts in adulthood. Primary TBM is congenital and starts as early as birth 4d2659101d

Active articulators are organs capable of voluntary movement which create the constriction, while passive articulators are so called because they are normally fixed and are the parts with which an active articulator makes contact. Along with the manner of articulation and phonation, the place of articulation gives the consonant its distinctive sound 4d2659101d

The collar typically encircles the lower neck in an oval shape and is padded to conform to the horse's anatomy.
