Avulsed deciduous (primary) teeth should not be replanted. Deciduous teeth are not replanted because of the risk of damaging the developing permanent tooth germ. Pulp necrosis with draining fistula, crown discoloration and external root resorption are reported consequences of primary tooth replantation. Dental extraction Extractions are performed for a wide variety of reasons, but most commonly to remove teeth which have become unrestorable through tooth decay, periodontal disease, or dental trauma, especially when they are associated with toothache. exodontia, exodontics, or informally, tooth pulling) is the removal of teeth from the dental alveolus (socket) in the alveolar bone. In orthodontics, if the teeth are crowded, healthy teeth may be extracted (often bicuspid) to create space so the rest of the teeth can be straightened. Sometimes impacted wisdom teeth (wisdom teeth that are stuck and unable to grow normally into the mouth) cause recurrent infections of the gum (pericoronitis), and may be removed when other conservative treatments have failed (cleaning, antibiotics and operculectomy). This type of circuit interrupter cannot protect a person who touches both circuit conductors at the same time, since it then cannot distinguish normal current from that passing through a person. The device's purpose is to reduce the severity of injury caused by an electric shock

Dental avulsion Typically, a tooth is held in place by the periodontal ligament, which becomes torn when the tooth is knocked out. The user (most likely a fire department) attaches a hose to the fire hydrant, then opens a valve on the hydrant to provide a powerful flow of water, on the order of 350 kilopascals (51 psi); this pressure varies according to region and depends on various factors (including the size and location of the attached water main). The user can attach this hose to a fire engine, which can use a powerful pump to boost the water pressure and possibly split it into multiple streams. Dovetail joint It is common to slightly taper the socket, making it slightly tighter towards the rear of the A dovetail joint (also dovetail, or in Europe a swallowtail, culvertail or fantail joint) is a joinery technique most commonly used in woodworking joinery (carpentry), including furniture, cabinets, log buildings, and traditional timber framing. A series of pins cut to extend from the end of one board interlock with a series of 'tails' cut into the end of another board. The pins and tails have a trapezoidal shape. Once glued, a wooden dovetail joint requires no mechanical fasteners. dovetails are assembled by sliding the tail into the socket. Noted for its resistance to being pulled

apart, also known as tensile strength, the dovetail joint is commonly used to join the sides of a drawer to the front

Nose-blowing may be used to alleviate nasal congestion (stuffy nose) or rhinorrhea (runny nose) resulting from colds, seasonal allergies, expel excessive nasal mucus created from crying or to expel nasal irritants. Dental emergency Dental emergencies do not always involve pain, although this is a common signal that something needs to be looked at. inadequately in the socket or it is broken down, a painful infection may develop which is often referred to as a 'dry socket'. Pain can originate from the tooth, surrounding tissues or can have the sensation of originating in the teeth but be caused by an independent source (orofacial pain and toothache). It is clinically characterized A dental emergency is an issue involving the teeth and supporting tissues that are of high importance to be treated by the relevant professional. Depending on the type of pain experienced an experienced clinician can determine the likely cause and can treat the issue as each tissue type gives different messages in a dental emergency

Fire hydrant requires special tools to be opened, usually a large wrench with a pentagonal socket. Underground fire hydrants have been used in Europe and Asia since at least the 18th century. Above-ground pillar-type hydrants are a 19th-century invention. Vandals sometimes cause monetary loss by wasting water when they open hydrants A fire hydrant, fireplug, firecock (archaic), hydrant riser or Johnny Pump is a connection point by which firefighters can tap into a water supply. It is a component of active fire protection

Ground glass joint For example, a round bottom flask, Liebig condenser, and oil bubbler with ground glass joints may be rapidly fitted together to reflux a reaction mixture. For ball-and-socket joints (also known as Ground glass joints are used in laboratories to quickly and easily fit leak-tight apparatus together from interchangeable commonly available parts. This is a large improvement compared with older methods of custom-made glassware, which was time-consuming and expensive, or the use of less chemical resistant and heat resistant corks or rubber bungs and glass tubes as joints, which took time to prepare as well

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
