As a bulk carrier the ship had a gross register tonnage of 8,202 tons and a deadweight tonnage of 19,918 tons. Lumbar puncture Sometimes, lumbar punctures cannot be performed safely (for example due to a severe bleeding tendency). It is regarded as a safe procedure, but post-dural-puncture headache is a common side effect if a small atraumatic needle is not used. (LP), also known as a spinal tap, is a medical procedure in which a needle is inserted into the spinal canal, most commonly to collect cerebrospinal fluid Lumbar puncture (LP), also known as a spinal tap, is a medical procedure in which a needle is inserted into the spinal canal, most commonly to collect cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) for diagnostic testing. Increased intracranial pressure (pressure in the skull) is a contraindication, due to risk of brain matter being compressed and pushed toward the spine. The main reason for a lumbar puncture is to help diagnose diseases of the central nervous system, including the brain and spine. Examples of these conditions include meningitis and subarachnoid hemorrhage. It may also be used therapeutically in some conditions 18a4d9d320

A loupe does not have an attached handle, and its focusing lens(es) are contained in an opaque cylinder or cone. They generally have higher magnification than a magnifying glass, and are designed to be held or worn close to the eye 18a4d9d320

== Structure == 18a4d9d320 Root canal anatomy consists of the pulp chamber and root canals. Both contain the dental pulp. The smaller branches, referred to as accessory canals, are most frequently found near the root end (apex), but may be encountered anywhere along the root length. The total number of root canals per tooth depends on the number of the tooth roots... 18a4d9d320 The purpose of a colonoscopy is to inspect the internal lining of the colon wall, to detect ulceration or precancerous polyps, and to permit biopsy or removal of suspected colorectal cancer lesions. 18a4d9d320 Colonoscopy surveys the entire colon, which runs 120 to 150 cm (4–5 ft). Sigmoidoscopy is similar, but only surveys the sigmoid colon, which comprises 60 cm of the distal (left) side of the colon. The benefits of colonoscopy for cancer survival have primarily been associated with the detection of lesions in the distal portion of the colon. 18a4d9d320

At the center of every tooth is a hollow area that houses soft tissues, such as the nerve, blood vessels, and connective tissue. This hollow area contains a relatively wide space in the coronal portion of the tooth called the pulp chamber. These canals run through the center of the roots, similar to the way graphite runs through a pencil. The pulp receives nutrition through the blood vessels, and sensory nerves carry signals back to the brain. In the case of irreversible damage to the pulp, root canal treatment can relieve associated dental pain. 18a4d9d320 == Description == 18a4d9d320 The main benefits of IR techniques are that they can reach the deep structures of the body through a body orifice or tiny incision using small needles and wires. These benefits are weighed against the additional risks of lack of immediate... 18a4d9d320 == How does it Work? == 18a4d9d320 In dentistry, local anesthetic medications (LA) are often used to control any potential pain that may occur with procedures. Local anesthetic injections are given in specific areas of the mouth, rather than the whole body. Although several different medications are available, the most commonly used local anesthetic to prevent pain in the area around a tooth is lidocaine (also called xylocaine or lignocaine). Lidocaine's half-life in the body is about 1.5–2 hours. The time it takes for the anesthetic medication to prevent pain in the area (speed of onset) and length of time that the area does not have painful sensations are considerations when choosing an appropriate approach to dental treatment. Other considerations include procedural considerations, the presence of inflammation, techniques used to administer the anesthetic medication, and adverse effects. In root canal treatment, for example, more Lidocaine is required than for a simple filling. 18a4d9d320 The most common method of crowning a tooth involves taking a dental impression of a tooth prepared by a dentist, then fabricating the crown outside of the mouth. The crown can then be inserted at a subsequent dental appointment. This indirect method of tooth restoration allows use of strong restorative material requiring time-consuming fabrication under intense heat, such as casting metal or firing porcelain, that would not be possible inside the mouth.
