Tamil phonology Tamil phonology permits few consonant clusters, which can never be word initial. solidified, compare Kannada which only had [s] as the medial allophone, Tamil ñāyiru, Kannada nēсарu. Its script does not distinguish between voiced and unvoiced consonants; phonetically, voice is assigned depending on a consonant's position in a word, voiced intervocalically and after nasals except when geminated. The earliest well-known brahmin writers in Kannada were from the Hoysala court.
