The law in its current form finds its root in Section 295A of the Indian Penal Code, enacted by the British Administration in India. This section was inserted into the Indian Penal Code in 1927 via an amendment in the backdrop of a series of murders of Arya Samaj leaders who polemicized against Islam. This began in 1897 with the murder of Pandit Lekhram by a Muslim because he had written a book criticizing Islam. Koenraad Elst argues that "Section 295A was not instituted... Established under the Constitution of India, the Supreme Court has extensive powers in the form of original, appellate and advisory jurisdictions. As the apex constitutional court, it takes up appeals primarily against verdicts of the High Courts of various states and tribunals. As an advisory court, it hears matters which are referred by the president of India. It also has the power of judicial review... Presidential appointees...

Specifically, the CCR investigates allegations of discrimination based on race, sex, national origin, disability. the Civil Rights Act of 1960, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and the Fair Housing Act of 1968 were built. Four are appointed by the President of the United States, two by the president pro tempore of the Senate (upon the recommendations of the Senate majority leader and minority leader), and two by the speaker of the House of Representatives (upon the recommendations of the House majority leader and minority leader). 2754de204f Islam first spread in southern Indian communities along the Arab coastal trade routes in Gujarat and on Malabar Coast shortly after the religion emerged in the Arabian Peninsula. Later, Islam arrived in the northern inland of the Indian subcontinent in the 7th century when the Arabs invaded and conquered Sindh. It arrived in Punjab and North India in the 12th century via the Ghaznavids and Ghurids conquest and has since become a part of India's religious and cultural heritage. Supreme Court of India The Supreme Court of India is the supreme judicial authority and the highest court in India. It is the highest appellate court for all civil and criminal cases in India. It has operated from the Supreme Court building in New Delhi since 1958. The court is led by the Chief Justice of India and has a maximum sanctioned strength of 37 judges excluding the chief justice. It is the highest appellate court for all civil and criminal cases in India. With expansive authority to initiate actions and wield appellate jurisdiction over all courts and the ability to invalidate amendments to the constitution, the Supreme Court of India is widely acknowledged as one of the most powerful supreme courts in the world. India is the supreme judicial authority and the highest court in India. It was established on 28 January 1950, two days after India became a republic, and replaced the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council as the highest court of appeal 2754de204f

The first Law Commission was established during colonial rule in India by the East India Company under the Charter Act 1833 and was presided over by Lord Macaulay. After that, three more commissions were established in British India. The first Law Commission of independent India was established in 1955 for a three-year term. Since then, twenty-two more commissions have been established. On 7 November 2022, Justice Rituraj Awasthi (Former Chief Justice of the Karnataka HC) was appointed as the chairperson of the 22nd Law Commission and Justice KT Sankaran, Prof.(Dr.) Anand Paliwal, Prof. DP Verma, Prof. (Dr) Raka Arya and Shri M.
