81df86d117 The exact cause of the condition is often unclear. Cases may involve a combination of allergy and poor venous return. The type of dermatitis is generally determined by the person's history and the location of the rash. For example, irritant dermatitis often occurs on the hands of those who frequently get them wet. Allergic contact dermatitis occurs upon exposure to an allergen, causing a hypersensitivity reaction in the skin. 81df86d117 Photodynamic therapy is the general use of nontoxic light-sensitive compounds that are exposed selectively to light, whereupon they become toxic to targeted malignant and other diseased cells. Still, PUVA therapy is often classified as a separate technique from photodynamic therapy. 81df86d117 The head of the first instar larvae is dark brown, while the body is light yellow and slightly transparent. The head of the mature larvae is dark brown, and the body is yellowish brown. The body length of a mature larva is about 2.7 mm. Larvae have hairs on the back of their chest and legs. The last two segments of the body each have a pair of horns-shaped protrusions with the tips facing backward. The pupa of *F. taiwana* is about 2 mm long. The newly formed pupa is light brown and turns dark brown as the adult insect nears emergence. 81df86d117 The main symptom is itchy papules (raised skin) that commonly occur within two days of infection. Initially, wheals develop quickly, then turn into maculae in about half an hour. Within 10–12 hours they turn into very itchy papules that reach their worst by the second or third day. The papules disappear in one or two weeks but secondary effects from scratching can continue longer. The intense itching, which peaks after 48–72 hours, is associated with pain and swelling of the affected areas. People repeatedly exposed to cercariae

develop heavier symptoms with faster onset. 81df86d117 Treatment of PN follows a multimodal, stepwise approach, ranging from topical corticosteroids and phototherapy to biologic agents targeting the type 2 inflammatory pathway. Because PN is frequently associated with systemic diseases (such as diabetes and renal disease), peripheral neuropathy, and psychiatric comorbidities (anxiety and depression), effective clinical management requires simultaneous addressing of skin lesions, neurological symptoms, and psychosocial factors... 81df86d117 Clinically, the diagnosis of PN relies on the characteristic morphology of skin lesions, their distinctive anatomical distribution, and the pattern of chronic severe pruritus. Epidemiological data indicate that the global prevalence of PN is approximately 0.083%, predominantly affecting adults and the elderly, with higher incidence rates observed in females and individuals of Black ethnicity. 81df86d117

Golfer's vasculitis It tends to spare areas covered by socks or shoes. It is more common in elderly or obese people. It occurs in the lower legs, and is caused by excessive walking in hot temperatures. Itching: Many patients report mild to moderate itching (pruritus) in the Golfer's vasculitis, also called exercise-induced vasculitis, sport-induced vasculitis, Disney rash, or hiker's rash, is a form of small blood vessel inflammation resulting in a rash. affecting both legs equally 81df86d117

They are photosensitizing agents found in plants naturally and manufactured synthetically. Psoralens are taken as pills (systemically) or can be applied directly to the skin, by soaking the skin in a solution that contains the psoralens. They allow UVA energy to be effective at lower doses. When combined with exposure to the UVA in PUVA, psoralens are highly effective at clearing psoriasis and vitiligo. Bites are most often found on the head, neck, and back. Over 2,200 species of black flies have been formally named, of which 15 are extinct. They are divided into two subfamilies: Parasimuliinae contains only one genus and four species; Simuliinae contains all the rest. Simuliidae are related to the Ceratopogonidae, Chironomidae, and Thaumaleidae. Over 1,800 of the species belong to the genus *Simulium* 81df86d117

PUVA therapy To the hands and legs PUVA may be more effective. The psoralen is applied or taken orally to sensitize the skin, then the skin is exposed to UVA. Narrowband UVB therapy is less effective for the legs and hands, compared to the face and neck. The reason can PUVA (psoralen and UVA) is an ultraviolet light therapy treatment for skin diseases: vitiligo, eczema, psoriasis, graft-versus-host disease, mycosis fungoides, large plaque parapsoriasis, and cutaneous T-cell lymphoma, using the sensitizing effects of the drug psoralen 81df86d117
