

Back Hurts On Right Side

The album's title was revealed in December 2012, followed by the track listing and artwork in January and February 2013, respectively. Hurts singer Theo Hutchcraft came up with the title while sitting in a bar in Osaka; he glimpsed it on a scrolling billboard, and it was the only word he could understand. "That sense of being in a weird place. Freedom, fear, isolation, joy, religion, punishment, the decadence that comes with exile—always being on tour, always far away from home. It did feel like we were on the run, always chasing something".

The event had hundreds of participants and sparked a national debate over Confederate iconography, racial violence, and white supremacy. In 2020, it was selected for preservation in the United States National Film Registry by the Library of Congress as "culturally, historically, or aesthetically significant". The film was released by Warner Bros. Pictures on November 20, 2009, and was a commercial success, grossing \$309 million on a \$29 million budget. Despite mixed reviews from critics, Bullock's performance was universally praised, leading to her winning the Academy Award for Best Actress, the Golden Globe Award for Best Actress in a Motion Picture - Drama, and the Screen Actors Guild Award for Outstanding Performance by a Female Actor in a Leading Role.
