Throughout church history, this gift has often been viewed as a teaching gift and connected with being able to understand scriptural truth. A predecessor concept was used in creating some concordances. == Rationale == Description == In computer programming, addressing modes are primarily of interest to those who write in assembly languages and to compiler writers. For a related concept see orthogonal instruction set which deals with the ability of any instruction to use any addressing mode. The term sight words is often confused with sight vocabulary, which is defined as each person's own vocabulary that the person recognizes from memory without the need to decode for understanding. The name VLIW derives from the instruction format found in almost all implementations, where the compiler bundles operations intended to execute simultaneously into a single, wide instruction word dispatched to execution units as one unit. These words can be extremely wide—implementations have used instruction words of 1 kilobit or more. But this is only a side effect of the natural
