Entity-relationship modeling was developed for database and design by Peter Chen and published in a 1976 paper, with variants of the idea existing previously. The second process incorporates Coad's ideas of using a feature list to manage functional requirements and development tasks. The other processes are a result of Jeff De Luca's experience.
